Activities Undertaken:

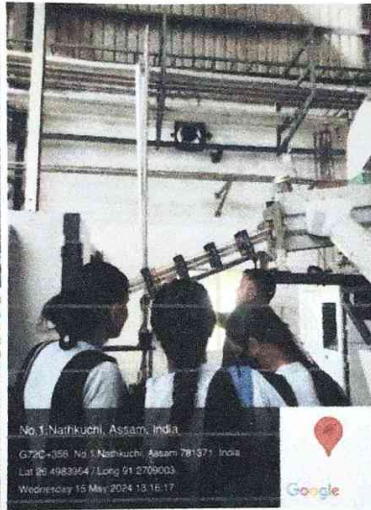
During the visit, the students were taken to the following locations:
