The programme drew active participation from a large number of students of the college, demonstrating strong youth engagement and enthusiasm for health-related causes.

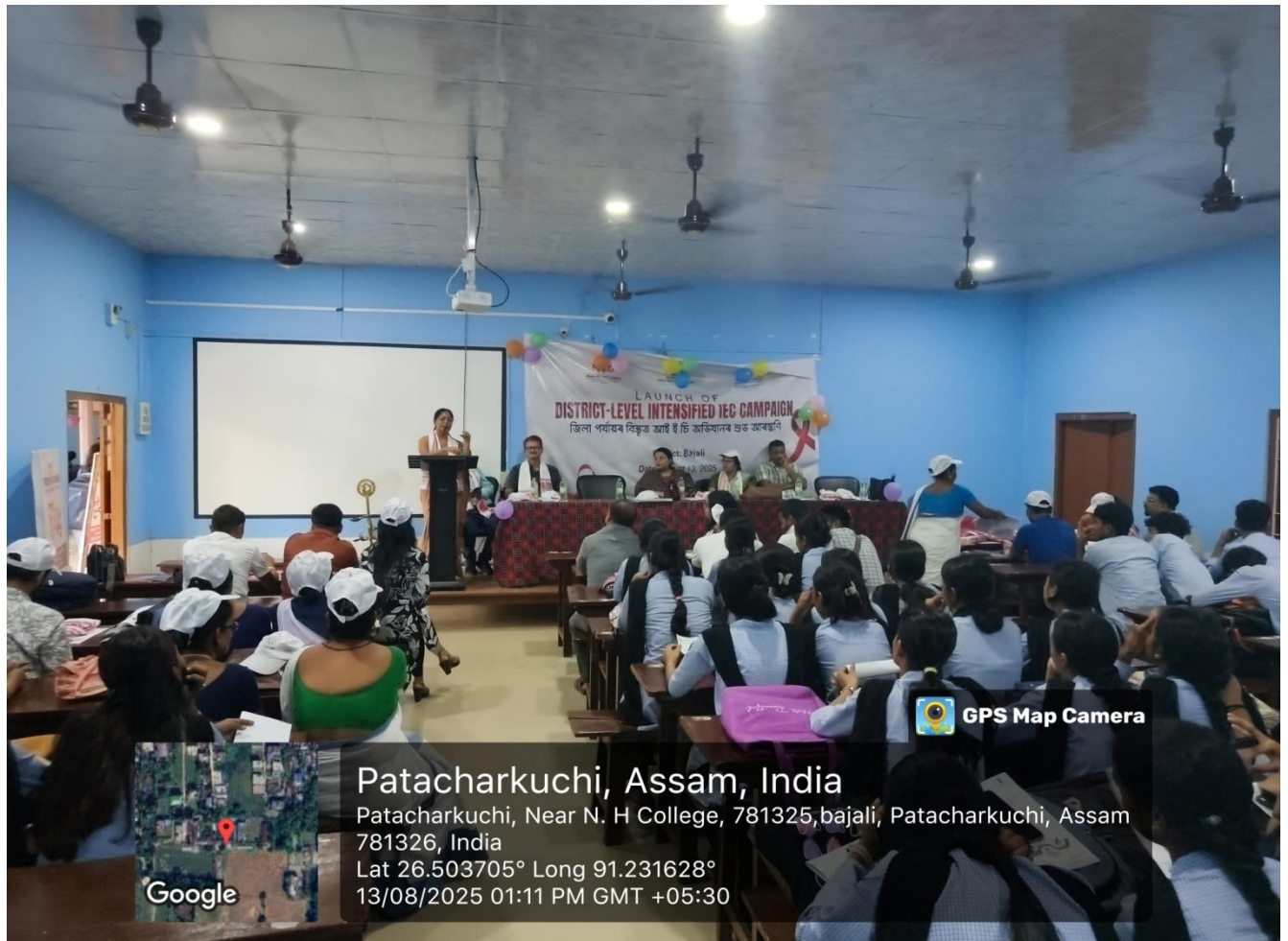
