

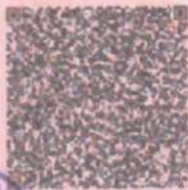

Development of mutually beneficial programmes/activities/training among the students & Stakeholders, collaboration in the field of Teaching-learning, Research & Extension Activities for establishing close linkage, functional coordination and promote cordial relationship between the institutions.

This memorandum of understanding (MOU) is made on this, 4th July, Friday, 2025 between **Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya**, a University under the Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya Act, 2017 and having its office at Nasatra, Barpeta, Assam, PIN: 781307 represented by its **REGISTRAR** hereinafter referred to as the "**FIRST PARTY**"

AND

Principal, Nirmal Haloi College, Nirmal Haloi College, Patacharkuchi, Bajali, Assam, PIN: 781326, Contact No.: 9435028402, Mail Id: nhcollege.pkc@rediffmail.com hereinafter referred to as "**SECOND PARTY**" represented by.....

Scope of the MoU: The broad objective of this MoU is to have a common platform for Teaching-learning, Research & Extension Activities for the Faculties, Students and the Stakeholders. Internship and Training Programmes for Students, Joint consultancy and Project implementation and any other activities as agreed upon the parties.

1. Modalities of the MoU:

- a. To take up initiatives for exchange of information relating to activities in teaching-learning, research and extension activities of mutual interests.
- b. Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctoral Research Projects/Works to be carried in the FIRST PARTY campus and the SECOND PARTY as per the requirements and approved plan of work.
- c. The FIRST PARTY will facilitate the opportunities to the students, teachers and research scholars of the SECOND PARTY for pursuing Master Degree Programmes, GNM (General Nursing and Midwifery), B. Sc. Nursing, D. Farm, B. Farm, undergraduate (BPT) and postgraduate (MPT) Courses in Physiotherapy, Doctoral Degree Courses (Ph. D.) as per the relevant rules and regulations of the institution of the FIRST PARTY.
- d. The FIRST PARTY will consider certain laboratories of the SECOND PARTY based on the required facilities for accomplishing Project, holding Seminar, Workshops, mutual discussions programmes, conducting doctoral research and recognize faculty members as research supervisors subject to fulfilling the Ph. D. Supervisorship as per the FIRST PARTY norms.
- e. Both the parties will provide the field, laboratory and other facilities for internship of Undergraduate, Postgraduate level students and Ph.D. scholars to carry out mutually agreed upon research programmes.
- f. Research findings as a result of this collaborative work of both the parties could be jointly published in the public interest.

2. Faculty Exchange Programme: For smooth running of academic programmes faculties/students' exchange programme shall be taken up through mutual experiences in teaching-learning, research and extension. Honorarium, transportation and accommodation/ hospitality as per respective institution norms will be provided by the parties concerned.

3. Organization of Seminars/Symposia/Workshop/Training Programme: Both the parties agreed upon to organize short-term training programme/internship on certain topic of mutual interest; to organize seminar/conference/workshop of national and regional interest. These will bring academic exposures for the faculty members and students of both the parties.

4. Collaboration on Outreach Event: To have joint collaborative programmes by the parties to accelerate entrepreneurship, innovation and to conduct outreach activities for the benefit of the society.

5. Submission of Collaborative Projects: Based on the interest and expertise, the FISRT PARTY faculty members will collaborate with the eligible faculty members of the institution in a specific domain of Project Work, research activities and submit project proposal to funding agency and vice-versa. In all such cases, faculty members of both the institutions follow the guideline of funding agencies and rules of the respective parent institutions.

6. Study tour Programme: To jointly organize study tour programmes in location specific areas and interests.

7. Co-curricular activities (Sports, Culture, Debate, Quiz etc.): To jointly conduct some Inter University/college events, environmental programmes, nature's camp, field trip, sports, cultural programmes having common interest.

8. Role and Responsibilities:

- a. Both the parties will nominate/designate one nodal officer (not below the rank of Assistant Professor) from respective institutions for the smooth conduct of the programmes and facilitate implementation of any/or all agreement arising out of this MoU.
- b. To take up collaborative research work based on location specific problem on project mode on mutual agreement hereafter with appropriate funding by respective parties including externally funded projects
- c. Neither parties shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligations under this agreement due to the exigency beyond control of both parties.
- d. There will be no financial obligations on both the parties under this MoU.

9. Duration of the MoU, Amendment and Termination:

- a. This agreement shall be effective for a period of three years from the date of signing MoU. The MoU may be modified, renewed and extended with mutual written consent of both the parties. The modifications and changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/extended, unless otherwise agreed on.
- b. The agreement shall be deemed to expire on completion of the mutually agreed upon period.
- c. During the tenure of the agreement, parties hereto can terminate the agreement either for break of any terms and conditions of this agreement or otherwise by giving a one month prior notice in writing to the defaulting party, failure of either party to terminate the agreement on account of break or default by the other shall not constitute a waiver of that parties right to terminate this agreement.
- d. In the event of the termination of the agreement, the rights and obligations of the parties shall be settled by mutual discussions.

10. Sharing of the Facilities



- a) Both the parties have agreed upon to provide access to each other at their existing facilities, which includes laboratories and other facilities available at both the institutions for pursuing collaborative research work initiatives.
- b) Both the parties also agree that for usage of the laboratory space and instruments, prior request should be made by the party intending to use the other party's facilities indicating the type of work and duration of the work, as per the work elements.

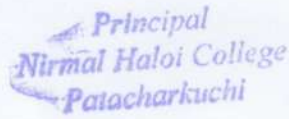
11. Intellectual Property Rights: Both the parties agree to respect each other's right to intellectual property linking to the ideas, inventions and patents generated during the MoU. The parties shall not pass or give usage rights of such property to any third party without the consent of the other party.

12. Arbitration: In the event any question, dispute or difference whatsoever arising between the parties to this MoU out of or relating to the operation or effect of this MoU or the validity of the breach thereof shall be settled by mutual consultation and discussion between the higher officials of both the parties.


13. Legal Relationship: The MoU shall be established as a statement of purpose to prompt a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the parties. Nothing in this MoU shall be constructed to create any legal relationship between the parties.


