Key Arguments

Proposition Team

- Decline in Physical Activity:** The team emphasized that mobile games encourage sedentary lifestyles, leading to decreased participation in physical sports.
- Distraction from Real Sports:** They argued that children and adolescents are more drawn to screens than outdoor activities, diminishing interest in traditional sports.
- Impact on Social Skills:** The team pointed out that reliance on technology reduces face-to-face interactions, which are essential for team sports and building community.
- Commercialization of Sports:** They highlighted how mobile games often prioritize profit over the essence of sports, diluting the competitive spirit.

Opposition Team

- Accessibility and Engagement:** The opposition countered that mobile games make sports more accessible, allowing individuals who may not participate in traditional sports to engage with sports culture in new ways.

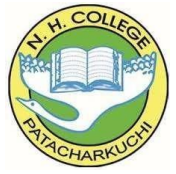
