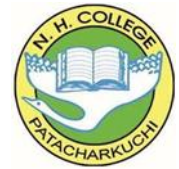


➤ Plantation Drive

➤ **Inauguration Session**

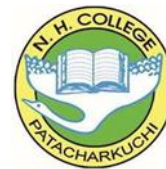

• Day 2 Activities (18th November 2025)

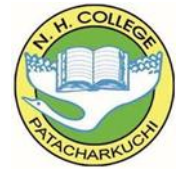

- Following the cleanliness efforts, a "Musical Chair" competition was held, promoting fun and camaraderie. The competition was lively, with enthusiastic participation from students.

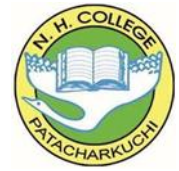


3. Drawing Competition

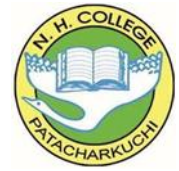
Activities Conducted

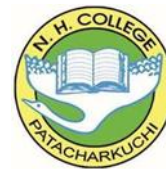


3. Bamboo Work Class for Kitchen Garden Fencing

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The third day of the NSS camp effectively combined education and practical skill-building, aligning with the broader goals of community service and personal development.

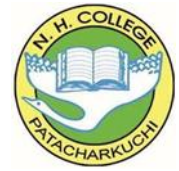
• 4th Day of NSS Special Camp (20 November 2025)

- **Description:** Following the singing competition, a recitation competition took place. This activity not only fostered public speaking skills but also helped students build confidence in their expressive abilities.



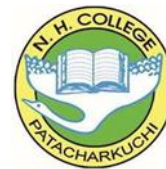
3. Making the Kitchen Garden

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The fourth day of the NSS camp successfully combined cultural activities with practical work, enhancing students' skills and encouraging their involvement in communal and environmental projects.

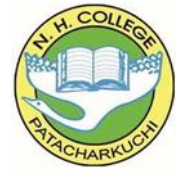
• 5th Day of NSS Special Camp (21 November 2025)

The sixth day of the NSS special camp successfully blended physical fitness with cultural education, fostering a sense of discipline and teamwork among students.

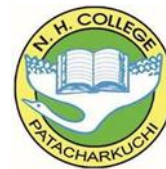


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• 7th Day of NSS Special Camp (23 November 2025)
